\*CSD major courses:

**First Level:** LCD 105, 106, and 110. (Students must **obtain a 2.6 (C+) or above GPA average across these 3 courses, before the student can enroll in LCD 207, 208, or 216.** **One course retake allowed.**

**Second Level:** LCD 207, 208, 216 (each with a grade of B- or better). Students may retake at most one 200-level course, one time, if they received a grade below B-.

**Third Level:** LCD 309, 316, 322, 323, and 330. Students may retake at most one 300-level course, if they received a grade of C- or below. *No course will count toward this major with a grade lower than C-.*

\*\*Required Courses for the CSD major that can be taken anytime:

-One (1) from list of electives: LCD 120; LCD 130; LCD 205; LCD 206; LCD 209; LCD 392; Psych 221; Psych 359; Soc 211. *Please check if pre-requisites are necessary in the above classes.*

\*\*\*Three credits in the Biological Sciences and three credits in the Physical Sciences are recommended, but not required of the major. Chemistry and Physics are highly suggested for Physical Sciences. Students applying to graduate schools in communication sciences and disorders will need these two courses as a pre-requisite. General Electives: Students may complete general electives by taking courses in (most) department/s or programs they choose; however, depending on the course/program, students may need department permission and/or prerequisite course/s. Electives may be used to supplement the chosen major (an English major may want to take a course in French or Italian literature) or to fulfill interest in a different area (a Music major may be interested in the physics of sound). Students are encouraged to use available electives to complete a dual major, minor, pre-requisites for graduate or professional school, or complete and internship, experiential learning and/or study abroad. Students are encouraged to use their available general electives wisely and focus on coursework that will assist them personally, academically and professionally.
