First Level: LCD 105, 106, and 110. (Students must obtain a 2.6 (C+) or above GPA average across these 3 courses, before the student can enroll in LCD 207, 208, or 216.). One course retake allowed.

Second Level: LCD 207, 208, 216 (each with a grade of B- or better). Students may retake at most one 200-level course, one time, if they received a grade below B-.

Third Level: LCD 309, 316, 322, 323, and 330. Students may retake at most one

300-level course, if they received a grade of C- or below. No course will count toward this major with a grade lower than C-.
