Candidates have a certifying letter from a college of education that they are eligible for initial certification in New York State or have a current certification and include a copy of the documented information with their application materials. Minimally candidates need the equivalent of a major in the language of certification (21 credits above the intermediate level), a score of advanced low or higher on the OPI and Writing Proficiency Test (WPT) Please register at www.languageTesting.com and select Academic, to register for the Academic test. Candidates cannot register for 743, 785, or 786 without those scores on the OPI or WPT. You must take 584 as prer or co- requisite to 743.
