REPORT DATE	Report includes all registration actions encoded before date shown.
INST ID: NAME/ADDRESS	Six-digit ID number, abbreviated institution name, address.
AUTHORIZED DEGREES	Indicates the degrees authorized both in the charter and in the master plan, the degrees authorized in the charter and master plan but with some restrictions specified by the Regents, and the degrees authorized in the charter but not in the master plan.
COUNTY CODE	Standard Higher Education Data System numeric county code.
INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL	Coded as follows: Non-degree, 2-year, 4-year (4-year + graduate), and Graduate (graduate only).
REGENTS REGION	The Regents Higher Education Region in which the institution is located.
INST ACCREDITATION	Indicates accreditation by the appropriate regional accrediting agency. For New York institutions, this is the Middle States Association.
APPROVED EXTENSION CENTERS	Names, locations and approval dates of currently approved extension centers.
PROG CODE	Program Code is a unique numeric identifier assigned to each individual program and should be used when referencing the program.
PROGRAM TITLE	Title is listed as approved in registration document (abbreviated to fit within the 40-character field provided on the Inventory).
HEGIS	Higher Education General Information Survey code for classifying academic subject areas.
AWARD	Abbreviation of degree, certificate, or diploma granted upon successful completion of the program.
CR/CL HRS	For programs leading to a diploma or certificate, the number of credit hours or clock hours is shown.
1 <sup>ST</sup> REG/LST REG	Date program was first registered./Date of latest registration action.
COND DATE/TBT DATE	COND date means that a program is registered with conditions until the date shown. TBT date means that a program is scheduled to be terminated.

DEGREES AWARDED

Three years of data on degrees awarded in the program.

PRGRS REPRT

Date a Progress Report is Due

VISIT TYPE/DATE

Type and date of the most recent site visit in which SED staff participated (S – State Education Department, P – professional accrediting agency, R – regional association such as Middle States).

TAP, APTS, VVTA

These columns indicate whether the academic program is eligible for students to be considered for the State student financial aid programs: TAP, the Tuition Assistance Program; APTS, Aid for Part-Time Study; and VVTA, Vietnam Veterans Tuition Awards. Student eligibility is determined separately.

UC

Unit Code – relates to review and registration authority for the program.

FORMATS

Abbreviation for programs approved to be offered in special scheduling formats or delivery modes (e.g., EVE, evening program; BILNG, bilingual).

PROF ACCR

The State Education Department cooperates with certain specialized accrediting agencies for purposes of program evaluation. This column lists abbreviations of such accrediting agencies which have extended approval to the program. Generally related to professional programs.

CERTIFICATE/LICENSE  
TITLE/TYPE/EFF DATE

Indicates that successful completion of the program fulfills the academic requirements for listed teacher certificate or professional license. Indicates type of teacher certificate: Provisional, Permanent, or Prov/Perm; or indicates that the program is Licensure-Qualifying. Shows the date on which the program was approved for certification or licensure purposes.

### General Information

**"Multiple" Programs:** Multiple programs were formerly known as DUAL, JOINT, or DUAL/JOINT programs. They can take the form of Multiple-Institution (M/I: two or more institutions cooperating in offering a program), Multiple-Award (M/A: two or more degrees awarded for a single combined program), or Multiple-Institution-and-Award (M/I/A: two or more institutions cooperating in a program for which two or more awards are granted). Such programs appear in the listing once for each HEGIS Code or Degree Level, and once for each institution involved. Where the HEGIS code is the same for both degree levels (for instance, a BS/MS in Computer Science) there will be an appearance of duplication because the program will be listed in its entirety once for the BS level and once for the MS level. It is less confusing where the combination is BS (Math)/MS (Computer Science), because the listings are in separate HEGIS codes.
