

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

PRIMARY COLLEGE COMPETENCIES^{*}

- English 110** [] Exemption only by examination.
- Math 110** [] Exemption by placement into Precalculus or Calculus on the CUNY Math Proficiency Exam, passing an equivalent course in Precalculus or Calculus, passing the NYS Math B Regents (or Sequential III Math or Intermediate Algebra & Trigonometry), or a score of 3 or higher on the Calculus Advanced Placement Exam. (Math 110 is an acceptable substitution for students who were previously required to take Math 06.)
- Language** [] Three semesters up to the intermediate level *or* exemption only by departmental examination *or* completion of the third level of high school language *or* the NYS Regents Comprehensive language exam *or* Competency Examination in American Sign Language.
- Phys. Ed.** [] One course from FNES 11 through 30.

If these students have less than one year of a foreign language at the college level, however, they will be requested to gain or demonstrate proficiency at that level.

[†] The three courses taken to satisfy the *Physical & Biological Sciences* and *Scientific Methodology & Quantitative Reasoning* requirements must be in two or more departments.

[‡] English 120W counts as one of the three required writing intensive units. At least one writing intensive course must be taken in residence at Queens College.
