Carl Phillips has published twelve books of poetry: *In the Blood* (1992); *Cortege* (1995); *From the Devotions* (1998); *Pastoral* (2000); *The Tether* (2001); *Rock Harbor* (2002); *The Rest of Love* (2004), winner of the Theodore Roethke Memorial Foundation Poetry Prize and finalist for the National Book Award; *Riding Westward* (2006); *Quiver of Arrows* (2007); *Speak Low* (2009); *Double Shadow* (2011); and *Silverchest* (2013). He also is the author of a book of essays, *Coin of the Realm: Essays on the Art and Life of Poetry* (2004), and a translation of Sophocles's *Philoctetes* (2003). He is a Professor of African and Afro-American Studies and Creative Writing at Washington University in St. Louis.
