Prior to or concurrent with SEYS 364, **candidates must pass the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and Writing Proficiency Test (WPT)** with a rating of at least Advanced Low **in order to qualify for ICE**. Please register at www.languageTesting.com and select Academic, to register for the Academic test. All candidates must earn a **B or better in Methods in order to qualify for ICE**. All candidates are also required to complete a portfolio as both an exit and certification requirement for Queens College.

All students are required to complete 100 hours of fieldwork prior to the Initial Clinical Experience (ICE).
