  - a) MOTION: Duly made (Reuder), and seconded:  
 "To postpone, indefinitely, Section III."
  - b) MOTION: Duly made (Warren), seconded and passed:  
 "To close off debate."  
 Reuder motion - passed.
4. Article VII, Section IV -
  - a) MOTION: Duly made (Hevesi), and seconded:  
 "To postpone, indefinitely, Section IV."

- b) MOTION: Duly made (Fleshler), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate."

5. a) MOTION: Duly made, and seconded:

Request for a roll-call vote - failed.

NOTE: (Alsop) - To be recorded in the minutes that the Secretary of the Academic Senate, Leif Rubinstein, is not present.

- c) Motion to accept Article VII - failed.

## 6. Article X, Section I.

Editorial change (Towers) - The word "Academic" to be inserted before the word, 'Placement'. The name of the Center is - Center for Testing, Academic Placement and Evaluation.

## 7. Article X, Section II.

- a) Editorial change (Fields) - Line two, word to read "selected" instead of 'appointed'.

- b) Amendment (Orzick) - "To add the following sentence after the words, 'appropriate persons':

"The President shall submit his or her selection for the Director, to the Senate for approval."

- c) MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To accept Article X, as amended."

## 8. Article XI - Transfer Students.

- a) Amendment (Alsop) - "To delete the words, 'in no less than four months', and add the words, "as expeditiously as possible."

- b) MOTION: Duly made (Mandelbaum), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate."

Alsop amendment - passed.

d) Amendment (Livote) - "To add after the words, 'a committee' in first sentence, the words, "to be approved by the Academic Senate."

Request for quorum call. There was a quorum.

e) MOTION: Duly made (Hecht), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate."

Livote amendment - failed.

f) Friendly amendment (Gilbert) - "To add after the word, 'committee' in the first sentence, the words, "to be made up of three faculty members and three transfer students presently at Queens College."

MOTION: Duly made (Towers), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate."

Gilbert amendment - failed.

g) MOTION: Duly made (Fleshler), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate on Article XI."

MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To accept Article XI, as amended."

9. MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To adjourn."
