- B. Notice of Intent can be give either by:
 - 1. Distributing the proposed Bylaw revision with the call of the meeting, or
 - 2. Distributing the proposed Bylaw revision at a meeting along with oral notification on the Senate floor.
- C. Proposed Bylaw revisions may be amended on the Senate floor. Any proposed Bylaw revision so amended may not come up to a final vote for at least one week after the last amendment has been accepted.
- D. A Bylaw revision on which debate has been closed without a final vote being taken, shall be a special order as the first item of business at the following week's meeting. The proposed Bylaw revision can then be reopened for further amendment and/or debate by majority vote.
- E. A proposed Bylaw revision that is not amended on the day it is formally introduced, can be called to a final vote that day."
- 3. a) MOTION: Duly made (Wettan), seconded and passed:

"To consider the proposal from the Undergraduate Scholastic Standards Committee, for a change of grading policies."

b) MOTION: Duly made (Wettan), and seconded:

"To consider grading proposal, seriatim."

c) MOTION: Duly made (Fass), seconded and failed:

"To postpone consideration of the grading proposal until Senate meeting on February 7, 1974."

d) MOTION: Duly made (Warren), seconded and passed: (4:30 p.m.)

"To have the Senate move into a quasi-Committee of the Whole, for one hour, to discuss the grading proposal."
