

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC SENATE OF QUEENS COLLEGE - October 24, 1974

5. MOTION: Duly made (Bermiss), seconded and passed (by acclamation):

"Be it resolved, that the Academic Senate endorse and proclaim November 12, and 13, 1974, Queens College Health Fair Days;

Be it further resolved, that the Academic Senate urge all members of the College community to participate in the lectures, testing, and workshop programs included in the Health Fair."

6. MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To adjourn."
