

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC SENATE OF QUEENS COLLEGE - October 9, 1975

1. The Holder of the Chair, Larry Mansfield, called the meeting to order at 3:35 p.m.

2. Approval of Agenda -

a) MOTION: Duly made (Gumenick), seconded and passed:

"To modify the agenda to make item 4-b, report by the Committee on Committees."

b) Editorial change (Mansfield) - Add under Approval of Minutes - minutes of May 29, 1975.

c) MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To adopt agenda, as amended."

3. Academic Senate minutes approved (as distributed): April 24, 1975, May 15, 1975, and May 22, 1975.

4. Approval of Minutes -

a) MOTION: Duly made, and seconded:

"To adopt minutes of May 29, 1975."

b) Editorial change (Greener) - page two, item 6, name to read "Leonard" instead of 'Larry'.

c) Senate minutes of May 29, 1975, adopted as amended.

5. Announcements, Administrative Reports and Memorials -

Chair announced the Executive Committee took the following actions for the Academic Senate:

a) Course and Faculty Evaluation questionnaire amended and adopted by the Executive Committee, and included with the mailing of the agenda for October 9, 1975 Senate meeting.

b) Executive Committee recommended to Provost Siegel that the present early registration period be continued.

Amendment (Gorkin) - "To add the words, "which may make recommendations to the Committee prior to distribution" after the words, 'Executive Committee'."

Seeing no further debate, Chair moved to an immediate vote.

Gorkin's amendment - failed.

Amendment (Hevesi) - "To add at the end of proposed standing rule, the words:

"as to style, grammar, and related technical problems, but not as to substance. Nothing in this rule shall be construed to permit the Executive Committee to veto or unduly delay or amend the substance of any document."

Seeing no further debate, Chair moved to an immediate vote.

Hevesi amendment - passed.

Standing rule, as amended - passed.

b) Report of the Executive Committee Sub-Committee on the Spring 1975 Senate elections -

MOTION: Duly made, and seconded:

"To accept items one through five, and the sub-committee's recommendations A and B, with the following editorial changes:

Item B-1, third line, change word 'all' to "the." After i.e. instead of word 'Sciences' should read, "Mathematics and Natural Sciences Division." Delete the letter s after word 'Division', and delete the words, 'and the Student-Faculty Disciplinary Committee'."

MOTION: Duly made (Roskes), seconded and passed:

"To amend A-2 to read - "Conduct balloting for the tenured faculty at large allowing space on the ballot for write-in votes."

MOTION: Duly made (Roskes), seconded and failed:

"To delete part A entirely."

MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To divide recommendations A and B."

MOTION: Duly made, seconded and passed:

"To accept item A-1 and A-2 (as amended)."
