

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC SENATE OF QUEENS COLLEGE
 Academic II - room 170

February 26, 1981

1. The Holder of the Chair, David Alsop, called the meeting to order at 3:45 p.m.
2. Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (Boylan) -

I. a) MOTION: Duly made:

"To adopt new courses in English (postponed from Academic Senate meeting January 8, 1981), as follows: English 001. Basic Writing, English 100. An Introduction to Composition, English 101. Composition, English 102. Introduction to Literature and Analysis."

Amendment (Held) - "To change the number of credits for English 101 and English 102 from 2 credits to 3 credits."

MOTION: Duly made (Fields), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate on Held's amendment."

Held's amendment - passed.

Seeing no further amendments, the Chair called for an immediate vote on the four English courses (with amendments to English 101 and 102).

Motion to adopt new courses in English, as amended - passed.

b) MOTION: Duly made: (to adopt the following re SEEK English courses):

"Students in the SEEK Program who achieve a score on the CUNY Assessment Test in writing which would place them in English 1 (currently a score of 9) shall be given the option of taking the SEEK English sequence of 100, 101, 102, or to enter English 1. The student should make the choice after consultation with a SEEK counselor and the Director of English Composition in the Department of English."

MOTION: Duly made (Shapiro), seconded and passed:

"To close off debate re SEEK English courses."

Motion - failed.

c) MOTION: Duly made, and passed:

"To adopt minor changes - English course withdrawn 001. Introduction to College Writing I."

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2. II. Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (continued)

a) Proposal of February 4, 1981, (Re Institute of Applied Social Science) - withdrawn.

b) MOTION: Duly made: (Undergraduate Curriculum Committee minutes of February 12, 1981):

"Be it resolved, that Queens College shall accept in principle the existing structure of the Institute of Applied Sciences offering a Bachelor of Science Degree consisting of 128 credits, with a concentration in Labor Studies.

1. The academic calendar shall consist of three 11 week terms where a full-time student usually will take two courses per term.
2. Most courses in this Program shall be assigned 4 credits each; many will have a field-based component.
3. The primary site of the Program shall be District 65 headquarters at 13 Astor Place in lower Manhattan.
4. The expectation is that as a part of the curriculum, the Queens College Basic Skills, area and foreign language requirements will be satisfied."

c) MOTION: Duly made (Mansfield), and seconded:

"To make the Minority Report (distributed today), the Substitute Motion."

d) MOTION: Duly made (Fields), seconded and passed: (4:50 p.m.)

"To move into a quasi-Committee of the Whole for one-half hour."

e) 5:20 p.m. The Holder of the Chair, David Alsop, asked if the Body would like to extend the quasi-Committee of the Whole for the next six speakers at the microphone. There was no objection.

f) 5:55 p.m. quasi-Committee of the Whole ended.

MOTION: Duly made (Fields), seconded and passed:

"To postpone definitely this item for next regular Academic Senate meeting on March 12, 1981, and make it a Special Motion."
