- 2 sessions

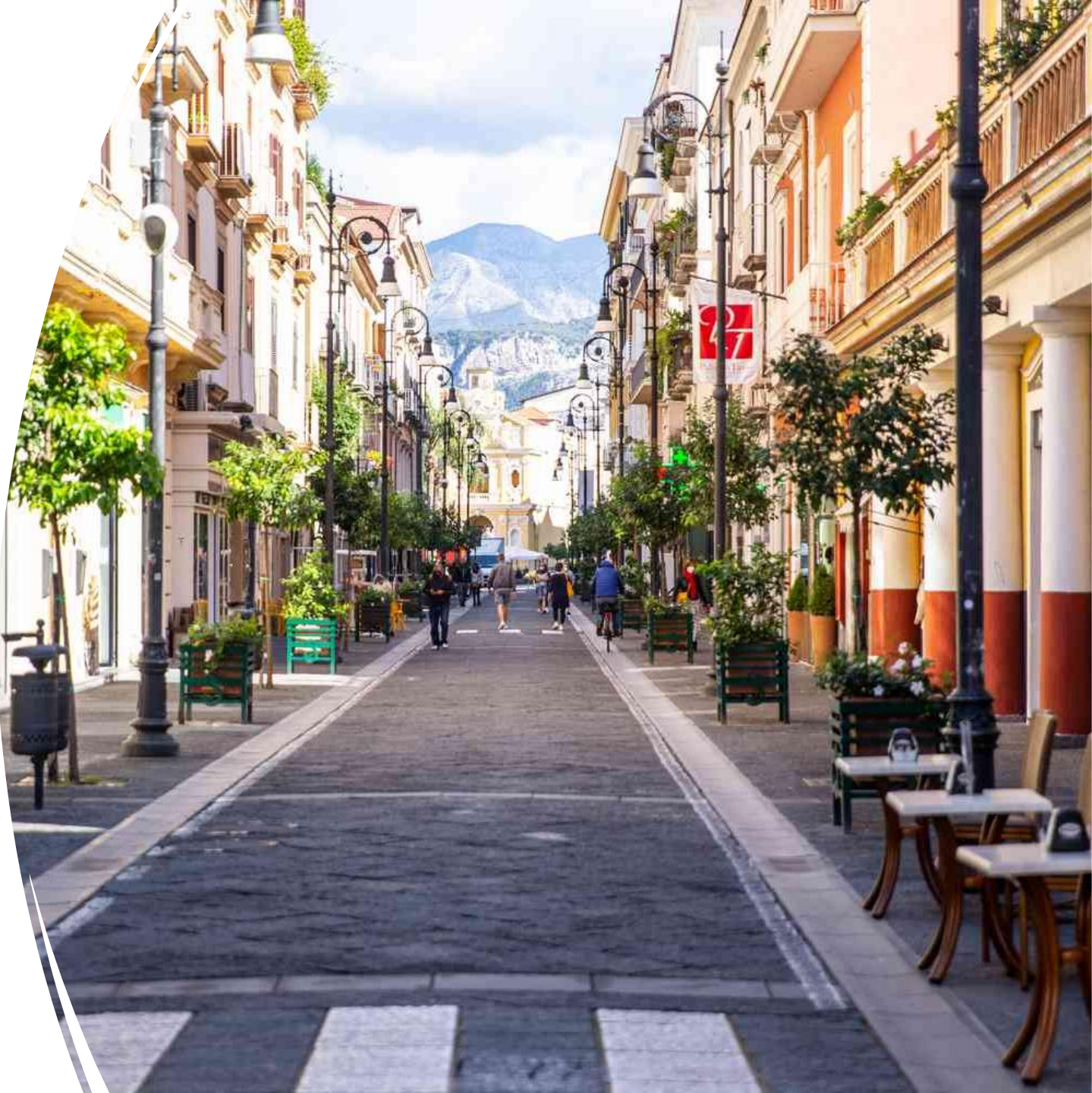

Program Details

- Winter:
 - Jan. 4th- 24th
 - 3 credits
- Summer:
 - May 31st - June 4th
 - July 5th– August 8th
 - 3-6 credits, courses and/or internship
- Spring semester:
 - Jan 25 – May 9th
 - 12-15 credits, courses and/or internship
- Group excursion
- Lots of clubs, sports, and activities
- All courses feature local field trips
- Language courses: self-placement
 - Can change within first week



Housing

- Residence Halls
 - On or off campus
 - Single, double, or triple rooms
 - Sea view or garden view

The city of Sorrento

Travel times to nearby attractions:

- Pompei: 40 min by train
- Naples: 1 hr 10 min by train
- Capri: 30 min by ferry
- Positano: 50 min by bus; 30 min by ferry
- Amalfi: 1 hr min by bus; 55 min by ferry

Fees

- \$400 administrative fee
- Program cost:
 - Winter: \$3,273
 - Summer: \$5,015 for 3 credits
 - \$5,935 for 6 credits
 - Semester: \$13,789 for 12-15 credits

*based on most affordable housing option
- Additional costs:
 - Internship fee: \$510 additional
 - Health insurance: \$61 per month
 - Flight
 - Meals
 - Meal plan required at off-campus residence hall:
 - Winter: \$265
 - Summer: \$450.50
 - Semester: \$1,404.50

- Sorrento
 - Campagna region
 - Beachy
 - Southwestern coast
 - Naples is nearest major city
 - Food – lots of fish options
- Perugia
 - Capital of Umbria
 - Hilly
 - Central Italy
 - Located between Florence and Rome
 - Food – lots of meat options



Eligibility

- 2.5 GPA, 3.0 for internships
- Good academic standing
- At least one semester completed at CUNY
- Seniors can attend

2. For Sorrento, complete the application on Sant'Anna's website in addition

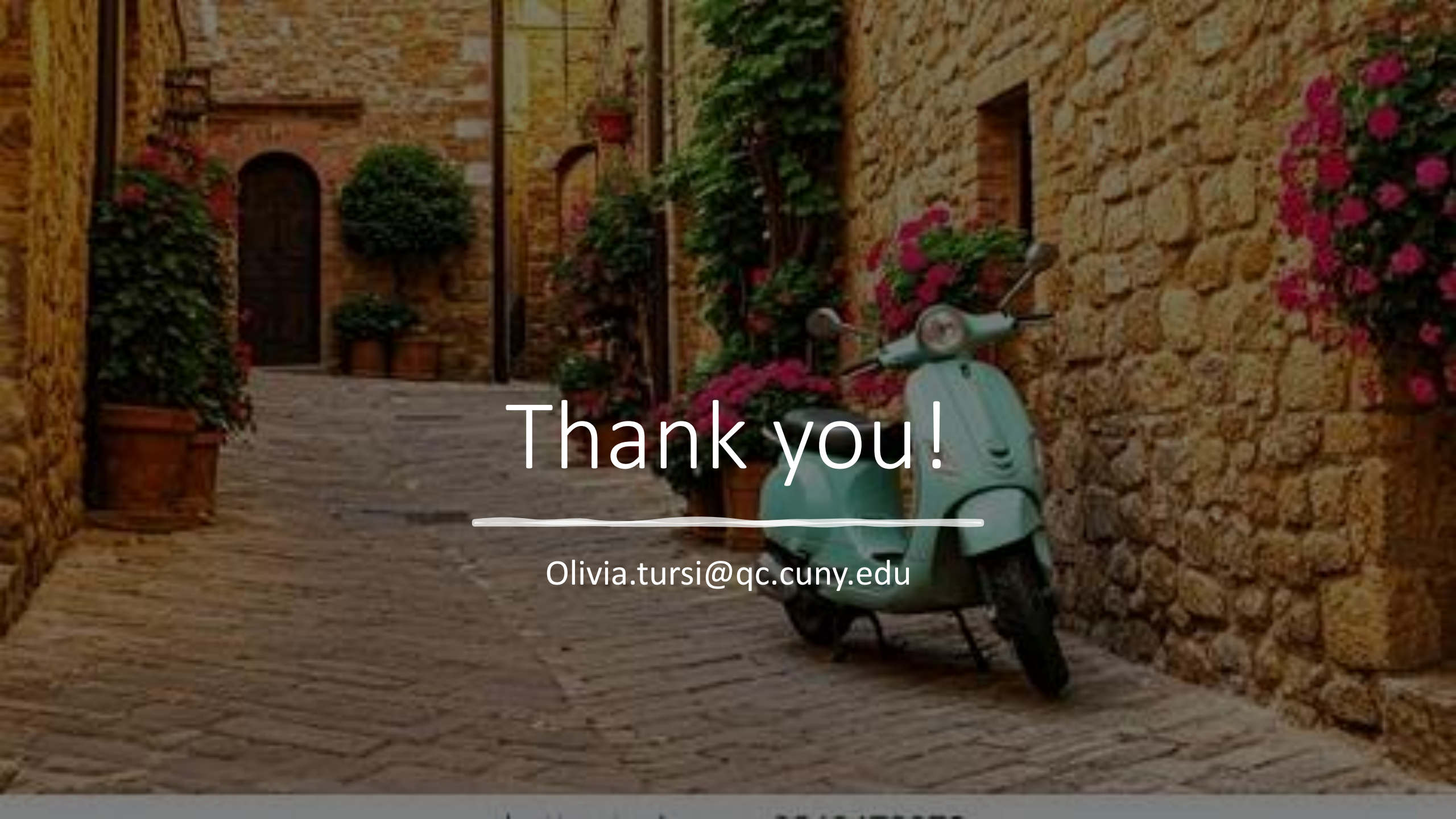
Application Deadlines
