Program details

- 2 sessions
 - June 3rd – 28th
 - July 1st – July 26th
- Pre-departure placement test
 - Levels A and B (beginner and intermediate): 18 hours/week
 - Level C (advanced): 22 hours/week
- 8 hours of weekly tutoring included
- Tour of city of Perugia
- Tour of Palazzo Gallenga
- Access to cultural activities for free

 - Estimated at \$600 a month

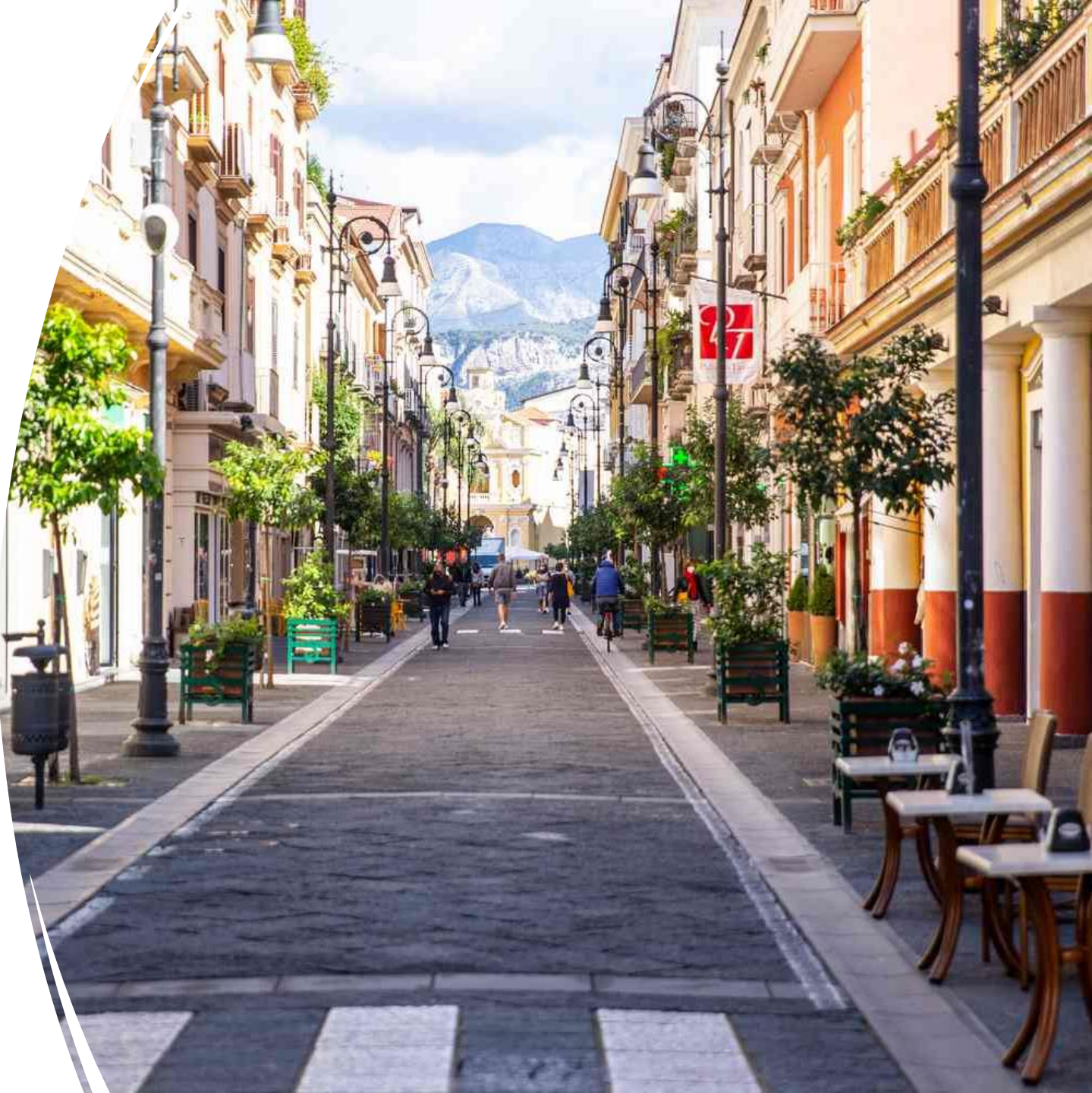

Program Details

- Two Sessions:
 - May 26 - June 29th
 - June 30th – August 3rd
- Choose 1 or 2 courses
- All courses feature at least one field trip
- Language courses: self-placement
 - Can change within first week



Housing

- Residence Halls
 - On or off campus
 - Single, double, or triple rooms
 - Sea view or garden view
 - All rooms have AC and a mini fridge
 - On-campus residence hall:
 - Large shared kitchen
 - Large outdoor terrace
 - Off-campus residence hall:
 - Small shared kitchen, cafeteria. Meal plan required at additional charge
 - Pool and sunbeds on rooftop
- Off-campus apartments
- Host family





The city of Sorrento

Travel times to nearby attractions:

- Pompei: 40 min by train
- Naples: 1 hr 10 min by train
- Capri: 30 min by ferry
- Positano: 50 min by bus; 30 min by ferry
- Amalfi: 1 hr min by bus; 55 min by ferry

Fees

- \$400 administrative fee
- 3 or 6 credits of CUNY tuition (\$915 or \$1,830)
- Program cost: \$3,690
 - based on most affordable housing option
- Additional costs:
 - Health insurance: \$61
 - Flight
 - Meals
 - If staying in off-campus residence hall a meal plan is required: \$450.50



Eligibility

- 2.5 GPA
- Good academic standing
- At least one semester completed at QC
- Seniors can attend



Application process

1. Complete application on Queens College study abroad website
2. Obtain 1 letter of recommendation
3. Write a personal statement (1 page)
4. For Sorrento, complete the application on their website in addition
