**Policy on Written Comments**

- Any member of the community may submit written comments about the Queens College MA Program in Speech-Language Pathology. All comments must relate to the program's compliance with the published Standards for Accreditation of Graduate Education Programs in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (Standards) in effect at the time comments are submitted, and must identify the specific program seeking candidacy, initial accreditation, or reaccreditation with the CAA.
- A copy of the Standards for Accreditation and the CAA's Policy on Public Comment [PDF] may be obtained online at <http://caa.asha.org/>, by contacting the Accreditation Office at ASHA, 2200 Research Boulevard, #310, Rockville, Maryland 20850; or by calling ASHA's Action Center at 800-498-2071.
- All written testimony must include the commenter's name, address, telephone contact information, and the commenter's relationship to the program in order for the Accreditation Office staff to verify the source of the testimony, including comments submitted via fax or as an email attachment. All comments must be signed. Comments not meeting these requirements will not be considered, and the individual or group comments will be so notified by the CAA.

Comments should be sent to the Accreditation Office no later than April 19, 2023, fifteen (15) days before the day of the scheduled site visit. Comments received after this date will not be forwarded to the site visit team for consideration during the accreditation review. Comments should be submitted by post or email to:
