Undergraduate Placement Exam—Sample questions

I. Keyboard piece.

To play at sight, hands together and at a moderate tempo.



II. Sight singing. To sing at sight to “LA” or to solfege syllables.



III. Dictation. Melodies will be at the same level of difficulty as the melodies to be sung at sight. Students should provide correct notation of both pitch and rhythm.
