Research in the Classroom Grant - Due: April 10, 2020

The CUNY Office of Research has a Research in the Classroom Grant (\$7,500) for innovative ideas to incorporate authentic research projects into the undergraduate curriculum. Successful projects may be implemented into new or existing courses but must incorporate authentic research. The research question should be based on the expertise of the PI, and should involve the development of new avenues of inquiry.

Applications encouraged from across all disciplines including the Arts, Humanities, Engineering, Natural Sciences and Social Sciences. A workshop will be held for successful applicants in June 2020 (please see program guidelines for more information).
