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World Language Education Assessment, Research and Practice

Purpose of program: For initially or professionally certified teachers, administrators, and Cooperating teachers wishing credits for salary differential, and professional development or in curriculum and assessment design, action research and current topics in World Language Education.

Credits: 3-9 credits (SEYS 743, 786, 767, 747)

Candidate eligibility requirement: Must have Initial Certification in a World Language.

Other information: This program is for teachers or administrators and QC Cooperating teachers.

World Language Immersion by Design

Purpose of program: A post masters program for World Languages focusing on immersion program development and related issues for curriculum, instruction, and assessment.

Credits: 12 (SEYSW 710, 743, 747, 767)

Candidate eligibility requirement: Must have Professional Certification in a World Language other than English (LOTE)

Other information: This program is for teachers, administrators, and QC Cooperating teachers.

Additional Certification in World Languages

Purpose of program: For initially or professionally licensed teachers in a world language who wish to be certified in an additional language.

Credits: 3 for those who are not currently in the QC MEd program (SEYS 743)

Candidate eligibility requirement: Teachers with at least initial certification in a World Language and seeking an additional language certification.

Other information: A minimum score of advanced on the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and Writing Proficiency (WPT), passing score on the Content Specialty Test (CST).

World Language Certification for other Secondary Education teachers

Purpose of program: For initially or professionally certified teachers in a content area who wish to add an additional certification in a World Language (LOTE: language other than English)

Credits: 6 credits in SEYS (564, 584); 6 credits in the designated language.

Content courses: One literature and one culture course.

Candidate eligibility requirement:

1. Teachers with at least initial certification in a secondary education subject other than a World Language or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages.
2. Teachers must demonstrate at least advanced low on the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and Writing Proficiency Test (WPT) prior to entering program.
3. Passing score on the Content Specialty Test (CST).
