Title and description: Il futuro “A modo tuo”.

The goal of this lesson is for students to practice the futuro semplice using audio-visual tools. The activities are designed to follow a grammar presentation of the futuro semplice that will take the students from the input to the final output stage. The purpose of this lesson is move from word level to phrase level, and finally to discourse level.

Type of Module: Grammar, listening.

Level: Elementary

Age group: 9- 12; University.

How to use this activity:

- Prior to watching the video, students should review the grammatical function of futuro semplice which they will need during the activities.
- Activity for vocabulary preparation “Cosa vedi?”:

This is a preparatory activity to help students to better understand the song “A modo tuo” by Elisa that will be played afterward. This is an input activity and does not require production. The purpose is to generate new words or phrases and learn new words/expressions of the Italian language and culture that are used in the song.

 - a. Print and attach the images provided below to the walls in the classroom. If the space does not allow students to move around, print the handout and distribute it to them.
 - b. Break students into groups of two and have them move around (or look at the handout).
 - c. Ask students to really look at these pictures and write what each image makes them think of. They should come up with a word or expression that describes each of these images.

Note: There is no right and wrong, but the point is to have them get to the specific word that will be needed for the lyrics. Remind your students that they can ask you how to say a word in Italian using the question “Come si dice “happiness” in italiano?”.
 - d. After all groups are done, write on the board the words they came up with and circle the one they will hear in the song (find them in session B below the images). If the word needed for the song has not come up, add it yourself.
- Activity for listening part “A modo tuo”:

This is a listening activity followed by comprehension exercises. Print the handout and distribute it to the students.

Part one:

- a. On your search engine, look for the song “A modo tuo” by Elisa.
- b. Play the song to your class once (no video needed).
- c. Play the song a second time. Ask your students to listen to it with closed eyes and say the words they recognized.
- d. Show them the first 50 seconds of the video and ask them: “Secondo voi, qual è il tema di questa canzone?”. They can write their answers in the designated space.
Note: this song is dedicated to the singer’s daughter on the day of her birthday and is a parent’s love letter to her child. It is a description of what the little girl’s future will look like.

Part two:

- a. On your search engine, look up the lyrics of this song and decide which words to substitute with a blank (note: They should be words your students can easily understand. Do not eliminate verbs in future tense). Here are some examples:
 - Domande
 - Giochi
 - Piccolo
 - Compleanno
 - Strada
 - Mondo
 - Facile
- b. Give students a copy of the song lyrics with the blanks.
- c. Play the song one more time.
- d. Students fill in the blanks.
- e. Have them listen to the song again to double check their answers.
- f. Have them underline all the verbs in the future tense.

Additional comments: The activities should take one class period. Ideally, have the group discussion in class and then have the writing activity completed at home.


