


550,000 people living in Northern Manhattan




\$30,000 per year is the minimum living wage in New York City.

Asthma per 100,000 residents




HOUSEHOLD INCOME

..... bottom 20% earned 88x less than the top 5%


Premature mortality per 100,000 residents



25% of NYC households are “underbanked,” meaning that they rely upon non-banks for crucial financial services such as cashing a check or purchasing a money order


30% of households in Washington Heights/Inwood are unbanked

Globally averaged sea-surface temperatures for 2015 were the highest on record for a calendar year, with 2014 in second place.
