HOW To Use EPERMIT to Sign up for a Class at SLU,:

Login to Cuny1st

Select Student Center

Select Academic Records

Select E-permit (on left hand drop down menu)

Select **“Add ePermit with Equivalent Courses”** select the appropriate Term and click Continue

Select the “Permit Type” = (Major Elective)

Host College = School of Labor and Urban Studies

Host Session = REGULAR

Host Career = UNDERGRADUATE

Subject/ Course Number = As listed above

!! Important – in the Comment section, make sure to put the QC course equivalent. I.e. HIST 274 = LHIST 301; LABST 240 = LABR 302; etc!!

Click SUBMIT
