



# TYPES OF X NEW YORK STATE GRANTS

Money that doesn't need to be paid back!



# TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (TAP)

The **TAP** is money granted from New York State to undergraduate students. It can grant from **\$1,000** to **\$5,556** each year within a 4-year or 5-year limit if approved for five-year degree program.

#### **PART-TIME TAP (PTAP)**

The part-time TAP (PTAP) is an extension of the standard TAP award, designed to support undergraduate students enrolled part-time (3 to 11 credits).

#### **SPECIAL PROGRAM (SEEK)**

**SEEK (Search for Education, Elevation, and Knowledge)** provides incoming freshmen with a required summer college–prep program and continues with academic, financial, and personal support for their academic journey.



# INCOME LEVELS FOR THE TAP APPLICATION

### **DEPENDENTS**

For **Dependent Students** and **Independent Students** with tax dependents the net taxable income limit for TAP is \$125,000.

# MARRIED INDEPENDENTS

For Independent Students who are married the net taxable income limit for TAP is \$60,000.


### **INDEPENDENTS**

For **Independent** and **Single** students the net taxable income limit for TAP is **\$30,000**.

The **NYS DREAM Act** allows undocumented and other eligible students to apply for one or more New York State aid, such as, **TAP** and **Excelsior Scholarship.** 


Plus it does **NOT require** the **FAFSA Application** to be filed.

- High school attendance in New York State.
- O High school completion in New York State.
- O In-state **CUNY**, **SUNY**, or a New York State **eligible private college** enrollment.
- O Citizenship or immigration status.

# NEW YORK STATE ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS APPLICATION



### ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

New York State offers an alternative eligibility application for students concerned about sharing sensitive personal family information, like a parent's or spouse's immigration status, on the FAFSA.

Alternative Pathways allows eligible students to apply for state-funded financial aid programs, including TAP, without completing the FAFSA.

- Visit <u>hesc.ny.gov/altpath</u> and click
   'Apply Today."
- Log into your portal or create a new account.
- Use a personal email address when creating an account. **Do NOT** use a school or work email.
- Click 'Add New Application.'

- Select the option that best describes your situation.
- Read all the instructions and confirm your selection.
- For help with the questions, visit the

- Begin the Alternative Eligibility Application.

# CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY

- Answer a few citizenship and immigration questions:
  - Social Security Number (SSN), level of study, school year, and residency.
- Click 'Submit' to continue with the application.

# YOUR STUDENT INFORMATION

- Enter your full legal name
- Date of Birth
- Address Information
  - You will be asked to enter only the city, state, and zip code.
- Opt in for notifications
- Student grade level
- Upload supporting documents, if required.

#### STEP 5

# SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION!

- Confirm your information is accurate.
- Electronically sign the application.
- Submit your completed application.

### **EXTRA TIPS!**

- Make note that when submitting your date of birth on the student information section, this date will reflect the birth date entered during account registration and will be *non-editable*.
- To correct this, you may contact
   <u>NYSDREAM@applyISTS.com</u> or call
   1-844-833-7129.
  - You will be **required** to submit a birth certificate or other necessary legal documents.

# EXCELSIOR TO SCHOLARSHIP

### Attend college tuition-free!

The **Excelsior Scholarship**, in combination with other student financial aid programs, allows students to attend a SUNY or CUNY college tuition-free.

A recipient of an Excelsior Scholarship may receive up to **\$5,500** for the academic year.

The application will be **available through the <u>HESC</u> website.** Please check their website periodically for availability.



#### REQUIREMENTS

- Graduate from high school in the **United States** or earned a high school **equivalency diploma.**
- Earn an income of \$125,000 or less.
- O Pursue an undergraduate degree at a **SUNY** or **CUNY** college.
- O Be enrolled in at least 12 credits per term and complete at least 30 credits each year.
- Graduate on time with an Associate's Degree in 2-years or a Bachelor's Degree in 4-years.

### **Excelsior Scholarship Program**

Students from families earning \$125,000 or less can attend a stateoperated SUNY or CUNY college tuition-free.



- Attend SUNY or CUNY tuition free!
- Adjusted combined federal household income of \$125,000 or less
- Pursuing an undergraduate degree at a SUNY or CUNY college or university
- Enrolled in full-time study (at least 12 credits per term in your program of study)
- Omplete at least 30 credits per year in your program of study
- State for a duration equal to the number of years you received the scholarship

# CONCLUSION (EXTRA TIPS)

- Do **NOT** wait until you are admitted to file your application (Dream Act/TAP).
- Apply to colleges by earliest possible deadline.
- Complete all questions accurately.
- You must re-apply for TAP each year.
- Know your school's priority and deadline dates.

- Keep copies of all documents for your records.
- TAP Application will be available every year in October.
- Check your email used on all applications:
   They communicate to the students first before colleges.
