**FORM 2: UNDERGRADUATE LIBERAL ARTS & SCIENCE MAJOR/CONCENTRATION PREREQUISITES**

APPLICANTS are required to have an undergraduate degree with a major/concentration of no fewer than 30 credits in one of the disciplines in liberal arts and sciences. Degrees with majors in vocationally-oriented areas, such as business administration (including but not limited to advertising, management, accounting, hospitality, and fashion merchandising), broadcasting, fashion design, or nursing do **NOT** meet this requirement.

**HOWEVER**, applicants with vocationally-oriented undergraduate majors may satisfy the liberal arts/sciences major requirement through an alternative method: They may complete 30 semester credits in one liberal arts/sciences field, without having officially received a degree in that field. Some business majors, for example, may have completed 30 credits in economics and broadcasting majors may have completed 30 credits in journalism. Interdisciplinary concentrations involve specific State requirements but may also satisfy this requirement; please consult with an advisor.
