Students will complete a pre- and post- internship survey based on the National Association of Colleges & Employers (NACE) competency assessment tool.	50% of students will report improved career readiness and professional development skills in the NACE communication competency after participating in an internship program.
	Community partners will complete a mid-year and end-of-program survey based on the NACE competency assessment tool.	50% of community partners will report student improvement in the NACE communication competency at the end of the internship program.
Students will demonstrate examples of career competencies they developed during their internship.	Students will use a tracker to reflect on progress on their goals and application of the NACE competencies.	All students will complete their tracker and identify examples of progress made on their goals and alignment to the NACE competencies.
	Students will create 1-3 STAR stories based on their internship experiences. The STAR (Situation, Task, Action, and Result) method illustrates examples of skill application to solve problems, overcome challenges, and deliver outcomes.	All students will complete one STAR story highlighting an example of a specific skill and its alignment to a NACE competency.
