Plan and develop an Assessment Showcase	The OIE will host an inaugural Assessment Showcase event to engage faculty and staff in developing their assessment plans, learning from each other, and learning about the many different ways we conduct assessment	80% of attendees at the Showcase event will respond affirmatively to exit survey statements about 1) knowledge gained and 2) their comfort level with assessment.
Partner with the Provost's Office to revise the academic department self-study process to serve as an engine of curriculum change, integrating DEI as a core value.	Development and implementation of a revised departmental Self-Study document that incorporates DEI principles	Drafted document submitted to Academic Deans, Associate Provosts, and the Provost by December 31, 2024; to Faculty Senate by March 2025; and published to the Provost's website by May 2025.
Restructure the OIE website to incorporate the Assessment pages currently housed under the Provost webpages.	Evidence of Assessment pages added to the OIE webpage menu with no remaining links or pages housed under the Provost webpages.	All previous Assessment page url's revised and redirected to live within the OIE webpages by February 2025.
