Guidelines for Initial Step Placement of Adjuncts

- 1. Generally, adjuncts should be placed at Step 1 of the appropriate teaching faculty level, that is, lecturer, assistant professor, associate professor, or full professor, depending on their qualifications and academic achievements.
- Adjuncts who teach at more than one CUNY institution should be placed at the step reported in CUNYFirst.
- 3. Adjuncts with at least six semesters of teaching experience at non-CUNY institutions within the preceding three years, including summers, may be considered for placement at Step 2. This is by analogy with the provision in Article 24 of the PSC/CUNY contract for adjuncts with experience at CUNY. Recommendation for placement at this step should come from the department chair and approved by the divisional dean.
- 4. In professional areas, the nature and duration of a professional career may be considered as reasons for placement at Step 2 or 3. Recommendation for placement at either of these steps should come from the department chair and approved by the divisional dean and the Provost.
- 5. Scarcity of qualified adjunct applicants for advanced or specialized courses may justify offering a higher step. Recommendation should come from the department chair and approved by the divisional dean and the Provost.
