Key Dates

- **May 16, 2026 – Spring 2026 grade rosters open.**
- **May 29, 2026 – Spring 2026 grade submission deadline for both graduate and undergraduate courses.**

Please be reminded that the final exam schedule follows an irregular pattern this term and must be used as posted.

Final Exam periods:

- Saturday to Monday, May 16 to May 18
- Wednesday to Tuesday, May 20 to May 26
